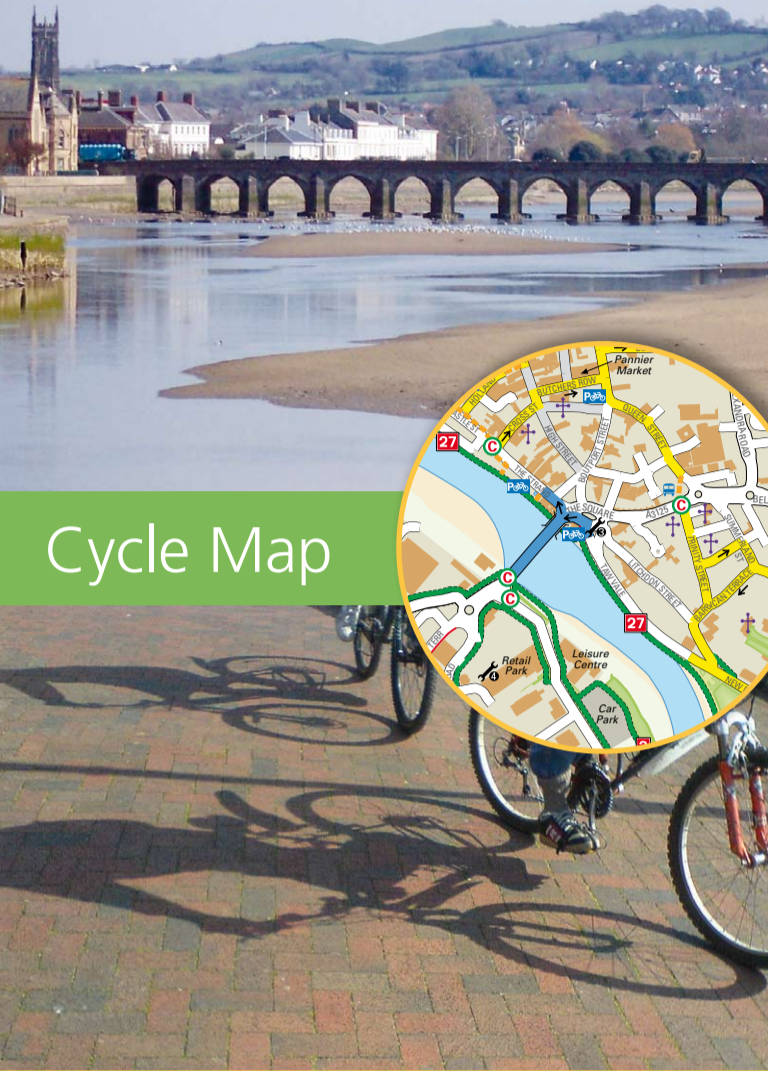

Cycles & trains at Barnstaple station



The train services to and from Barnstaple rail station (operated by First Great Western) normally carry bicycles. There is no booking and no fee for cycle carriage to Exeter Central or Exeter St Davids. It is wise to arrive early as cycles are taken on a first come first served basis. Officially two cycles per train are carried on these services. You may wish to speak with the train guard before boarding if you notice there are two cycles on the train before you board. The train guards often take a more flexible approach on less busy services.

If travelling by train further than Exeter, particularly if changing train and operator, it is best to book your cycle(s) T: 08457 484950.

Cycle parking stands are available at Barnstaple station but please note there are no lockable cycle cabinets or containers at the station. Please refer to the map overleaf for location of more secure cycle parking at the Park and Ride site and near the main library.
