A garden for everyone to enjoy throughout the year

An enchanting family-friendly garden, situated in the beautiful Torridge Valley between Dartmoor and Exmoor National Parks, RHS Garden Rosemoor is surrounded by woodland and enhanced by the natural beauty of North Devon.

As inspirational to the amateur gardener as it is awe-inspiring to nature lovers and plant enthusiasts, this haven of peace and tranquility is rich in variety throughout the seasons and features a huge diversity of planting displays.

Spring

As spring blooms, the Upper Woodlands become full of wood anemones; naturalised daffodils and fritillaries carpet the meadows; rhododendrons and camellias throughout the garden are all bursting into flower. In April and May, feast your eyes on vibrant bedding displays, magnificent magnolias, wonderful wisteria and Japanese ornamental cherry trees that are covered in blossom all around the garden. The Meadows are bright yellow with buttercups, while the streamside bursts into life and the Upper Woodlands are carpeted with English bluebells.

Summer

The largest rose gardens in the South West become an amazing fusion of colour and scent, whilst the Wildflower Meadows change into a dramatic yellow and purple haze. Then the Fruit and Vegetable Garden matures, and the vibrant colours of the Hot Garden, the Mediterranean and Exotic Gardens start to develop. At the same time the Cool Garden is a calm oasis of running water complemented by white, blue and yellow flowering plants.

Autumn

Early autumn and the Hot Garden is looking spectacular, a true magnet for insects. It's also harvest time in the Potager, Fruit and Vegetable Gardens and don't miss the Mediterranean Garden, Exotic Garden and the Southern Hemisphere Borders. By October, amazing autumn colour can be seen throughout the garden from acer, cornus, liquidambar, fruits, berries and grasses. In late autumn structure comes to the fore as hedges are clipped and fruit trees trained.

Winter

Don't miss the Winter and Foliage Gardens which are enchanting at this time of year. These gardens are filled with a surprising mix of colour, fragrance, texture and structure. Key highlights include national collections of Ilex (hollies) and Cornus (dogwoods); flowers such as daphne, mahonia, sarcococca, witch hazels (Hamamelis); the coloured willow (Salix) and dogwood stems; and the textures of silver birch, acers and cherry tree bark along with ornamental grasses. Through January and into February early camellias and drifts of snowdrops are also in flower.
